

Theory and Practice (based on TKT Modules 1, 2 & 3)

Syllabus 36 + 36 ach (18 sessions x 4 ach)

Aim: to get participants acquainted with key methodological points and practices and get them (better) able to use them in their teaching practice

Format: flipped classroom: course participants prepare in advance; at online sessions we discuss key points and practicalities

Practical tasks expected at sessions and as part of homework:

- Case study; cases are provided by the course tutor and participants
- Analysis of course book materials
- Micro lesson planning based on suggested materials and on course book materials used by participants at their regular lessons
- Adaptation of ready-made course book materials aiming at making them more effective
- Demonstration of different stages of lessons
- Further research on suggested topics

Assessment:

- Task completion at practical sessions
- Final assessment task: a ready-made lesson plan based on the materials teachers use with their students at regular classes
